Many thanks to the room parents, parent volunteers and Macon Hall teachers and staff members that helped make the carnival a success. It was "Wild" here on Friday night!

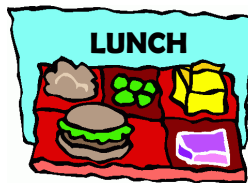
Lots of families came out and supported the carnival, and in the process we raised over \$11,000 for the school!
